Step-by-Step Guide to Setting Up IPTV on Your Firestick

Section 2: Installing a Downloader App

To sideload apps that aren't in the Amazon Appstore, you'll need a downloader application. The "Downloader" app is the most popular and user-friendly option.

1. Go back to the Firestick Home Screen: Press the Home button on your remote.
