### Prerequisites: What You Need Before Starting

1. The Smart IPTV App Installed: Download and install the app from your TV's official app store (LG Content Store, Samsung Smart Hub, or Google Play Store).
2. Your MAC Address: This is a unique identifier for your device. When you open the app for the first time, your MAC address will be displayed on the screen (e.g., `a1:b2:c3:d4:e5:f6`).

4. A Computer or Smartphone: You will need a secondary device to access the SIPTV website to upload the link.

### Step 1: Locating Your MAC Address

The MAC address is the key to connecting your subscription to your specific device.

1. Launch the Smart IPTV app on your TV.
2. On the main screen, look for a string of alphanumeric characters separated by colons. It usually appears in the center or the bottom right.
3. Write this down or take a photo of it. You will need it in the next step.

Note: If you have already used the app and the screen shows "No Playlist Found," press the "Settings" or "Info" button on your remote to find the MAC address again.

### Step 2: Uploading the Playlist via the SIPTV Website

Smart IPTV does not allow you to type in a long M3U URL directly on your TV using a remote (which would be incredibly tedious). Instead, you use their official website to "push" the playlist to your TV.

1. Open your web browser on your PC or smartphone and go to: '<https://siptv.app/mylist/>'.
2. You will see a section titled "Upload external playlist links (URLs), with auto-update." This is the preferred method because if [\[iptvbestprovider.org\]](https://iptvbestprovider.org) updates their channel list, your TV will automatically sync those changes.
3. In the field labeled MAC, enter the MAC address you noted from your TV.
4. In the field labeled URL, paste the M3U Link provided by [\[iptvbestprovider.org\]](https://iptvbestprovider.org).
5. Ensure the "Save online" checkbox is checked if you want the playlist to stay synced.
6. Select your preferred Logos and EPG (Electronic Program Guide) settings. Usually, selecting "Default" or "None" works best as the app will pull data from the link itself.
7. Click the "Send" button.

---

### Step 3: Activating the Playlist on Your TV

Once the website says "Success!" or "1 URL added! Restart the app," go back to your TV.

1. Using your remote, press the "Exit" or "Back" button to close the Smart IPTV app.
2. Re-launch the app.
3. Wait a few moments for the app to "Requesting playlist" and "Loading channels."

4. Depending on the size of the playlist from [iptvbestprovider.org](<https://iptvbestprovider.org>), this may take anywhere from 10 seconds to a minute.
5. Your channel categories (Live TV, Movies, Series) should now appear on the screen.

## Advanced Features: EPG and Logos

One of the reasons Smart IPTV is so popular is its clean interface. To make it look even better:

**EPG (Electronic Program Guide):** If your channels don't show "What's playing now," ensure that the EPG URL (also provided by [iptvbestprovider.org](<https://iptvbestprovider.org>)) is correctly linked. Most modern M3U links have the EPG data embedded.

**Groups:** Use the "Blue" button on your remote to sort channels by groups (e.g., Sports, News, UK, USA). This makes navigating thousands of channels much easier.

### 1. "Check URL" Error

Check if you entered the correct MAC address on the SIPTV website. If your TV is connected via Wi-Fi and then you switch to Ethernet (LAN), the MAC address might change. Always use the one currently displayed in the app settings.

### 3. Buffering or Freezing

Buffering is rarely an app issue and usually relates to internet speed or server quality. By choosing a premium service like [iptvbestprovider.org](<https://iptvbestprovider.org>), you minimize server-side lag. Ensure your TV is getting at least 20 Mbps for HD streaming and 50 Mbps for 4K.

This one-time payment grants you a lifetime license for that specific MAC address.
