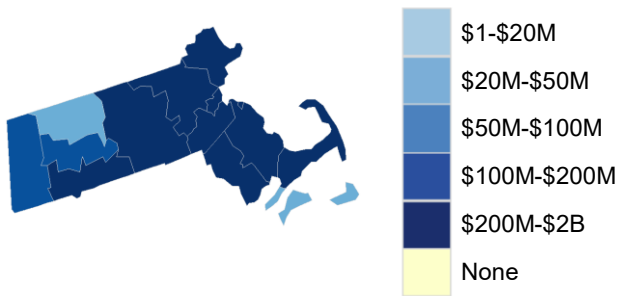




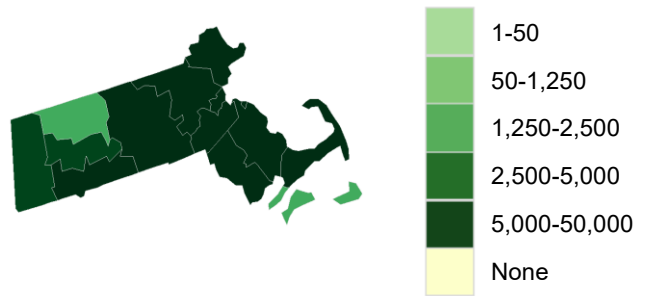
SBA Lending by Community Banks, 2010-2025

From 2010-2025, community banks provided a total of **24,120 loans** to Massachusetts small businesses through the Small Business Administration’s 504 and 7(a) lending programs, translating to **\$6.9B in direct local economic investment across 100% of MA counties**.
