





SBA Lending by Community Banks, 2010-2025

From 2010-2025, community banks provided a total of **6,270 loans** to New Hampshire small businesses through the Small Business Administration’s 504 and 7(a) lending programs, translating to **\$1.9B in direct local economic investment across 100% of NH counties**.
